## FLOOR DOOR INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

These are recommended guidelines. Locally accepted and/or mandated practices and procedures should be followed to ensure the long-term durability and operation of the Bilco® Floor Door installed into the various types of construction systems. This product may be installed on either a flat or sloping roof. When installed on a slope, the hinge side must run parallel with the slope. If slope exceeds 30°, advise factory for modification

## ■ INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. CAUTION: COVER IS SPRING LOADED. Do Not remove safety shipping bolt until unit is to be installed and in normal horizontal operating position. For Type FR and Type TER, remove restraint cable only after cover infill is in place.
- Bend anchors outward 45 degrees (angle frame type doors only). Remove safety shipping bolt and plate. Remove
  outside latch release handle taped to inside latch (on safety chain on Double Leaf doors). Remove threaded plug for
  access to outside latch release on channel frame doors only.
- 3. Be sure unit is set on slight pitch toward drain corner and that drain is connected (channel frame type doors only).
- 4. Before pouring concrete or anchoring in place, open and close door(s). Check to see that door(s) rests on frame all around. If not, shim under frame at proper corner. Check door operation.
- 5. With door(s) in closed position, pour concrete (if used) flush with top of frame. Use care to prevent concrete from getting into frame or around hinges. CAUTION: Support frame to prevent sagging. Do not permit weight of concrete to push frame inward and reduce clearance between door(s) and frame.
- 6. Doors with red oxide factory prime should receive a finish coat of alkyd metal enamel.
